

PROCEDURES FOR COMPLAINTS REGARDING LIBRARY MATERIALS

The Guilderland Public Library has a Freedom to Read policy (adopted by the Guilderland Public Library Board of Trustees May 23, 1995, reaffirmed July 11, 2002) and a Freedom to View policy (adopted Sept. 12, 1989, reaffirmed July 11, 2002) . The Library does not practice or support censorship in any form.

The Library will provide a “Request for Review of Materials” form (available separately) to anyone objecting to materials in the collection. All objections will initially be reviewed by the Director and, if necessary, the Board of Trustees. Each person filing a written Request for Review of Materials will receive a written response from either the Director or the Board of Trustees.
