You can pick up a copy of the Screening Questionnaire and Consent Form at the Adult Information desk to fill out in advance and bring with you to the clinic.

Drug Take Back Day

Saturday, October 29 @ 10-2 pm

Side Parking Lot

We're teaming up with the Guilderland Police Department once again to host the semi-annual nationwide Drug Take Back Day, a one-day

collaborative effort to safely remove potentially-dangerous controlled substances from our medicine cabinets.

Instructions:

- ▶ Put your medications in a bag, if possible
- ▶ Put bagged medications in a place that you can easily access while remaining in your vehicle, or place the bag in your trunk so an officer may retrieve it
- ▶ Proceed to the drop-off point and stay in your vehicle
- ► Follow the officers' instructions

What CAN be disposed:

- Controlled, non-controlled, and over the counter substances
- Medication in its original container or removed from its container and disposed of directly into the disposal boxes
- Pet medication

What CANNOT be disposed:

No sharps and syringes.

Drug Take Back Day officials will not ask any questions, nor request identification from anyone.


