
The Original New Yorkers: An Indigenous History of the Land

The Basics of Book Self-Marketing: With Author Karen DeBonis Saturday, September 23 @ 2 pm



layering period vocals to much of their music. Listening to their richly textured musical compositions is a lovely way to spend a Fall afternoon!




Edvard Munch: So Much More than *The Scream*

and wear comfortable clothes, suitable for movement. Please register for individual Monday evening sessions, scheduled through November. [R]


GPL Cabaret: The Jeanine Ouderkirk Duo


